As we begin our 24 day journey through Luke's Gospel, there's an important lesson to learn from verse 2:

those who from the beginning were eyewitnesses

We have the double assurance that what we are reading is reliable: eyewitness accounts overseen by God Himself in His inspired and infallible word, the Bible. We're going to learn about Jesus, the Saviour, and we're going to read about the certainty of salvation through faith in Him. When we reach chapter 19 we'll read:

for the Son of Man (the Lord Jesus) has come to seek and to save that which was lost.

We sometimes hear people refer to 'reason for the season' at this time of year. The Bible is clear about why the Lord Jesus came in to the world: it was to seek and to save that which was lost. When we trust Him as Lord and Saviour we can be certain that our sins are forgiven.
