In this chapter we read how the religious leaders tried to trip up the Lord Jesus in His words. This was impossible! He spoke only the truth, indeed He said in John chapter 15 verse 6:

I am . . . the truth . . .

Let's take time to read all of that verse:

Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me."

The first two words of that statement, '*I am*' actually form a title reserved for God (we can read about this in the Old Testament in Exodus chapter 2 verse 14). The Bible makes it clear that the Lord Jesus is God and that in becoming sinless Man He is the only way for flawed human beings to have a personal relationship with God.

No one comes to the Father except through Me.
