n chapter 3 we learn another important lesson. John The Baptist directs the people to the Lord Jesus. In verse 16 he says:

One mightier than I is coming, whose sandal strap I am not worthy to loose.

We notice that John says the Lord Jesus is mightier than he himself is. The fact is that the Lord Jesus is almighty for He is God. Significantly for us today He has the power to save. We read in an other book in the New Testament, Hebrews, in chapter 7 verse 25:

Therefore He is also able to save to the uttermost those who come to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them.

We can with confidence trust the Lord Jesus for salvation.

We also notice that John said the Lord Jesus is more worthy than he is. Again the truth is that He is more worthy than any other. We can read in the book of Revelation chapter 5 about a great future event when the cry will be:

"Worthy is the Lamb who was slain To receive power and riches and wisdom, And strength and honor and glory and blessing!"

Those who have trusted Jesus as Lord and Saviour anticipate that future event today by honouring and worshiping Him in their lives.
